



LET'S DRAFT!



Each player must have 4 Gem Blenders booster packs and an unlimited supply of basic gems (recommended 1 gem pack per 4 players)



Looking for a fun way to open packs, build decks, and play with friends? Try drafting!

A draft distributes the randomized cards in booster packs among 4-8 players in order to make brand new decks. This format creates a level playing field, and is a great opportunity to hold a tournament to see who drafted, crafted, and piloted the best deck!

HOW TO DRAFT

Each player does the following.

- 1** Open your first pack.
- 2** Take the hero and token cards from the pack, without showing the other players.
- 3** Pick any other card in the pack and (simultaneously with all other players) place it face up in front of you.
- 4** Pass the remaining cards to the left.*
- 5** Pick a card from the cards you've been passed without showing the other players. Pass the remaining cards and repeat step 5 until all opened cards are drafted.
- 6** Open your next pack and repeat steps 2-6.

**Alternate the direction for each new pack.*

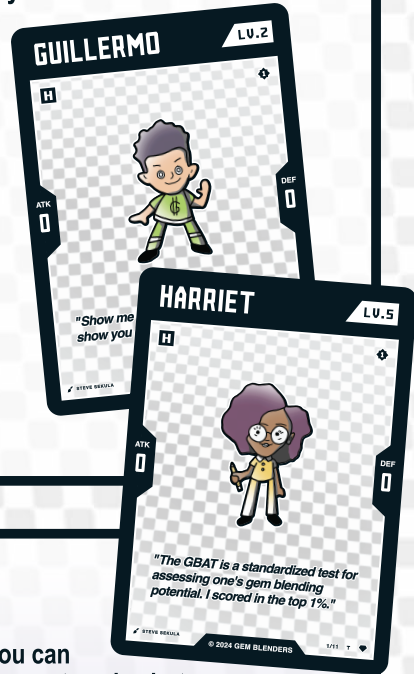
DRAFT DECK COMPOSITION

Now it's time to construct your deck using the cards you drafted! Drafted decks are similar to standard decks with a few key differences:

- ▶ 4-8 heroes
- ▶ 40-card deck of gems, blends, and actions

Adhere to the following deck building rules:

- ▶ No unique hero limit
- ▶ No identical card limit
- ▶ No action star limit
- ▶ Any number of basic gems (only basic gems may come from outside your drafted cards)
- ▶ Any number of hero tokens, but no more than 1 of each level



HERO TOKEN

If you need a certain hero level to finish your deck, you can use a hero token. Printed hero tokens are available in most packs, but any card can represent a hero token as long as you indicate its level at the start of the game. Hero tokens have no effect or stats, but they do have plenty of personality!
